## 4 LEVELS OF UNBELIEF...

### 1. Can be due to **lack of exposure**.

<sup>35</sup> The next day again John was standing with two of his disciples, <sup>36</sup> and he looked at Jesus as he walked by and said, **“Behold, the Lamb of God!”** <sup>37</sup> The two disciples heard him say this, and they followed Jesus. John 1:35–37 (ESV)

### 2. Can be due to **lack of information**.

<sup>16</sup> Jesus said to her, “Go, call your husband, and come here.” <sup>17</sup> The woman answered him, “I have no husband.” Jesus said to her, “You are right in saying, ‘I have no husband’; <sup>18</sup> for you have had five husbands, and the one you now have is not your husband. What you have said is true.” <sup>19</sup> The woman said to him, **“Sir, I perceive that you are a prophet.** John 4:16–19 (ESV)

### 3. Can be due to a perceived **lack of evidence**.

<sup>23</sup> Now when he was in Jerusalem at the Passover Feast, many believed in his name when they saw the signs that he was doing. <sup>24</sup> But Jesus on his part did not entrust himself to them, because he knew all people <sup>25</sup> and needed no one to bear witness about man, for he himself knew what was in man. John 2:23–25 (ESV)

### 4. Can be due to **hardness of heart**.

3. Believes and acts upon what **Jesus proclaims**. *John 4:50*
